Her university career ended in 2014 at Barry University and was named to the Sunshine State Conference Commissioner's Honor Roll. She was named the NFCA Scholar All-American and finished off 11-5 record and a 2.46 ERA and has won numerous pitching awards. Camille ended her minor career playing for the Warriors; she led the team into a gold medal in provincials for 5+ consecutive years. She has also pitched in many Canadian Western & National Championships and Western/Canadian Summer Games. Some of her more recent Career Highlights are:

2011 – 3rd at Junior Canadian Championships and named All-Star Pitcher

2012 - Named Adult Fast Pitch Player of the Year in Alberta. Zone 5 ASG Asst. Coach

2013 - 2nd at Western Canadian Championship in Saskatoon

2015 - MVP at Senior Women's Western Canadian Championship

2016 - Played in the European Cup in Czech Republic

2017 - 2nd at Senior A Women's Canadian Championships. Played for the Polish National team at the European Championship in Italy.

2018 - 1st at Senior A Women's Canadian Championships, named Top batter, All-Star First base men and named Adult Female Fast Pitch Player of the Year in Alberta. 2019 – 1st at Senior A Women's Canadian Championships. Played for the Polish National Team at the European Championship in Czech Republic, placed 12th. 2021 – Played for the Polish National Team at the European Championship in Friuli Venezia Giulia, Italy, placed 9th.
